
## **Record sheet**

Use this record sheet to record information about your conversation.


Ask the person for permission to use it.

Explain that using it will help you remember the person's story.


Explain that if a report is made to the police or an investigation occurs, the record sheet may need to be provided to police or investigators.



Place we talked about your safety




Date and time we talked about your safety
